# Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006 

## November 2013

## The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of November 2013.

The CPI for November 2013 is 116.62, a decrease of $0.3 \%$ compared to the index of October 2013 (117.00) and accumulating a decrease of $0.2 \%$ up to and including November of this year.
The percentage change of the CPI over the last 12 months (November 2012 to November 2013) is -0.4 , an increase of 3.1 percentage points (ppts) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (-3.5).
The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period November 2012 November 2013 is -2.7 , a decrease of 4.1 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period November 2011 - November 2012 (1.4).
During this month, six of the twelve sectors registered decreases in prices. The decrease which had the greatest influence on the CPI was registered for the "Transport" sector $(-1.3 \%)$, causing an effect of -0.23 ppts. The decreases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of -0.14 ppts on the CPI of November 2013.
Aforementioned decreases were partially offset mainly by an increase in the index for the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector ( $0.1 \%$ ), which had an influence of 0.02 ppts. The increases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of 0.03 ppts on the CPI of November 2013.
The decrease in the "Transport" sector was due to decreases in the categories "Operation of personal transport equipment" (-1.6\%) and "Purchase of vehicles" (-1.2\%), which contributed to an effect of -0.16 and -0.09 ppts, respectively.
The increase in the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector was caused by increases of $0.5 \%$ and $0.1 \%$ in the categories "Non-alcoholic beverages" and "Food", which together contributed to an effect of 0.02 ppts.
The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to October 2013, 39.4\% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 0.41 ppts, while $33.8 \%$ showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -0.73 ppts and the remaining $26.8 \%$ had no change in price. The prices of goods decreased by $0.7 \%$ and caused an influence of -0.44 ppts. The prices of services show an increase of $0.3 \%$ and had an influence of 0.11 ppts.
The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food - registered in November 2013 an increase of $0.2 \%$, which is 0.2 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year ( $0.4 \%$ ). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel - registered a decrease of $12.6 \%$, which is 16.3 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.7\%). The food index shows a decrease of $0.1 \%$, which is 3.2 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.1\%).
The subsistence level for a household consisting of two adults and two children (aged 014 years) in November 2013 is Afl. 4,257, a decrease of Afl. 15, compared to November 2012 (Afl. 4,272), while for a single adult household the amount is Afl. 2,027, a decrease of Afl. 7, compared to November 2012 (Afl. 2,034).

Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in November 2013

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In November 2013 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 94.42) had a decrease of US\$ 6.81 (6.7\%) compared to October 2013 (US\$ 101.23).

Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity up to 500 kWh did not change in November 2013, it stayed at Afl. 24.60 cents per kWh. Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity between $501-1000 \mathrm{kWh}$ did not change in November 2013, it stayed at Afl. 30.90 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to October 2013. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 306.75, while the average price of water per household remained at AfI. 137.05.

In November 2013 the price of gasoline decreased by Afl. $0.06(-2.9 \%)$ causing an effect of -0.19 ppts on the CPI. The price of diesel registered a decrease of Afl. 0.03 (-1.5\%) causing an effect of -0.01 ppt on the CPI of November 2013.

In November 2013, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show a decrease in price of $1.0 \%$ compared to October 2013, and had an influence of -0.19 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease of $0.2 \%$ in price, causing an effect of -0.13 ppts on the CPI.

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## Change in prices of Food \& catering services in

 November 2013The "Food \& catering services" index increased by $0.1 \%$ in November 2013, the same increase as in October 2013. The index for "Food at home" shows an increase of $0.1 \%$ in November, as six of the eleven "Food at home" indices increased in November 2013. The "Fish and other seafood" index registered the largest increase (1.0\%) in November. The indices for "Food products n.e.c." and "Non-alcoholic beverages" registered increases of $0.9 \%$ and $0.5 \%$, respectively. The "Potatoes and other tubers" index decreased the most ( $-2.5 \%$ ). The "Vegetables" index declined by $0.9 \%$. The indices for "Oils and fats" and "Sugar, jam, honey and other confectionery" posted decreases of $0.6 \%$ and $0.3 \%$, respectively.

Over the last 12 months the "Food \& catering services" index has increased by $0.5 \%$. The "Food at home" index shows an increase of $0.2 \%$. The "Fish and other seafood" index increased by $4.6 \%$, the largest increase among the "Food at home" food groups, while the "Fruit" index shows the largest decrease (-8.9\%).

The index for "Food away from home" shows an increase of $0.2 \%$ in November, after a slight decrease of $0.01 \%$ in October 2013 and has increased by $1.6 \%$ over the last 12 months.

In November 2013, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group show an increase in price of $0.1 \%$ compared to October 2013, and had an influence of 0.03 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of $0.4 \%$, causing an effect of -0.35 ppts on the CPI.
