


Graph 2. Deaths of Aruban residents abroad as a percentage of all resident deaths

According to the Population Registry Office 593 deaths were registered during the first three quarters of 2016, of which 569 were residents and 24 were non-residents.

- 5.1 percent of the resident deaths occurred abroad, of which 55.2 percent were female who passed away at an average age of 61.9 years. Males passed away at an average age of 65.6 years.
- Of the residents who passed away in Aruba, 50.9 percent was male (70.3 years at the time of death). Female residents died at an average age of 75.0 years.







During these first three quarters of 2016, a total of 2,042 persons registered at the Population Registry Office. A decrease of 25 percent compared to the first three quarters of 2015.

On average, the majority of registrations occur in the second and third quarter of a year. In 2016 however, after showing an

increase of 29.2 percent during January and February, a drop is seen in the subsequent months. The year-to-date numbers of 2015 show 2,738 persons registering, while in 2016 the totals dropped to 2,042 persons, a decrease of 34.7 percent. Although the decrease is more evident in the foreign-born population (a drop of 30 percent), the number of Aruban-born persons registering has also shown a slight decline (a drop of 6.2 percent). Taking a closer look at the country of birth of the foreign-born that were registered in 2016 a decrease was visible in persons from all countries of births. People born in the Dominican Republic and Colombia show the largest setback, with respectively 46.5 percent and 41.5 percent less registrations.
