

Foreign Trade, 3rd Quarter 2018

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Foreign Trade of the 3rd quarter 2018.

Total Import

The total import, in terms of **weight**, registered a decrease of 1.5% in the third quarter of 2018 (157.8 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2017 (160.2 mln kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total import increased by 10.2%, from Afl. 501.0 mln to Afl. 551.9 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered a decrease of 0.6% in the third quarter of 2018 (157.4 mln kg), compared to the same period in 2017 (158.4 mln kg). During this period four (4) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered decreases in terms of weight in import to the free circulation area of Aruba.

The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Mineral products" (-6.3 mln. kg), "Base metals and derivated works" (-1.6 mln. kg) and "Transport equipment" (-0.3 mln. kg).

The largest increase is seen for the section "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (2.1 mln. kg). Furthermore, increases of Afl. 1.3 mln kg and Afl. 0.9 mln kg were registered for the "Food products", and "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" sections, respectively.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (value)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 13.0% in the third quarter of 2018 (Afl. 544.5 mln) compared to the same period in 2017 (Afl. 481.8 mln). Seventeen (17) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered increases in terms of value in import to the free circulation area of Aruba.

The largest increases are observed for the sections "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (Afl. 15.5 mln), "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (Afl. 15.4 mln.), "Optical instruments, apparatus and equipment" (Afl. 7.2 mln). and "Food products" (Afl. 7.1 mln).

The largest decrease is seen for the section "Base metals and derivated works" (Afl. -2.7 mln). Furthermore, decreases were registered for the "Transport equipment" (Afl. -1.4 mln) and "Materials for the manufacture of paper, paperwork" (Afl. -0.6 mln) sections.

The abovementioned Import (to the free calculation area of Aruba) is the result of Import by Sea and Import by Air, which had the following effects:

1. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Sea

Import by Sea to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered a decrease of 0.7% in the third quarter of 2018 (156.7 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2017 (157.8 mln kg), while, in terms of value, the import by Sea increased by 12.9% from Afl. 403.0 mln to Afl. 455.1 mln.

2. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Air

Import by Air to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, increased by 19.5% from 0.61 mln kg in the third quarter of 2017 to 0.73 mln kg in the third quarter of 2018, while, in terms of value, the import by Air increased by 13.5% from Afl. 78.7 mln to Afl. 89.4 mln.


Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Large companies**

Import by "Large companies", in terms of weight, decreased by 6.4% from 25.0 mln kg in the third quarter of 2017 to 23.4 mln kg in the third quarter of 2018, while, in terms of value, it increased by 10.9% from Afl. 46.0 mln to Afl. 51.0 mln.

Total Export

The total export, in terms of **weight**, registered a decrease of 35.9% in the third quarter of 2018 (4.7 mln kg) compared to the same period of 2017 (7.3 mln kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total export decreased by 27.1% from Afl. 41.2 mln to Afl. 30.1 mln.

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered a decrease of 23.8% in the third quarter of 2018 (4.1 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2017 (5.4 mln kg). Eight (8) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered decreases in terms of weight in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" (-1.1 mln. kg), "Vegetable products" (-0.2 mln. kg) and "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (-0.2 mln. kg).

The largest increases are observed for the sections "Works of art, collectors pieces and antiques" (0.2 mln kg) and "Chemical products" (0.09 mln kg).

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba* (value)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered a decrease of 13.0% in the third quarter of 2018 (Afl. 20.3) compared to the same period in 2017 (Afl. 23.4). Twelve (12) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered decreases in terms of value in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" (Afl. -6.6 mln), "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (Afl. -0.6 mln) and "Real pearls (natural) and other precious stones" (Afl. -0.4 mln).

The largest increases are observed for the sections "Optical instruments, apparatus and equipment" (Afl. 2.1 mln), "Works of art, collectors pieces and antiques" (Afl. 1.6 mln), "Chemical products" (Afl. 0.9 mln) and "Transport equipment" (Afl. 0.6 mln).

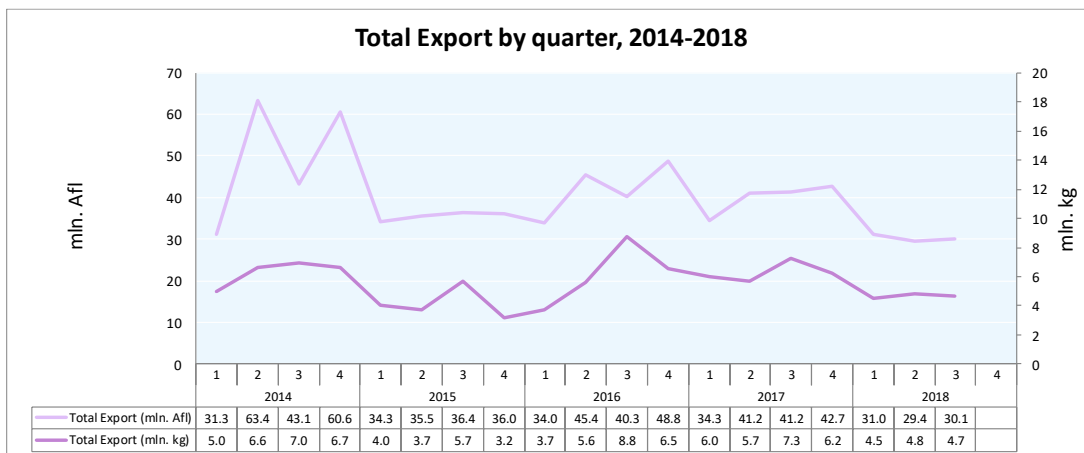
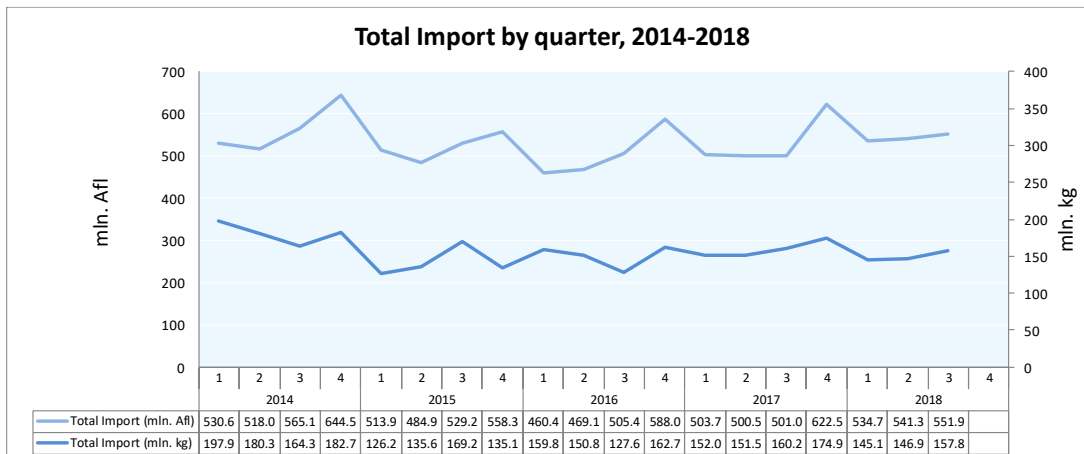
