

Population growth

The population increased with only 257 persons during the 1st quarter of 2007, totaling 103,746 persons. For the last 4 years, an average of 659 persons was added to the total population during the first quarters. The women outnumber the men by 4,849. 19.5% is younger than 15 years of age. 71.2% is in the working age category (15-64 yrs.) and 9.4% is 65 years or older. At the older ages the women outnumber the men by 1,499 persons. In the younger ages (15-) there are 280 more boys than girls.

Figure 1 Population growth, basis 2000





Figure 2 Live births by teenage mothers in percentage of total births, 1st quarters 2002-2007



Deaths

By the end of the 1st quarter 2007, 128 deaths were registered. 15.6% were younger than 50 years. A total of 7 persons died between the ages of 55 and 59 during this first quarter, of which one died just before turning 60. In 2006 9 persons died at age 59, of which 5 died just before turning 60 and 4 right after.

Live Births

During the 1st quarter of 2007 a total of 284 babies were registered at the Population Registry Office. 14.1% of these babies were born to teenage mothers. Comparing the 1st quarters of 2006 and 2007 in absolute numbers, the difference is only of one baby. Percentage wise this is 2.4% drop. As a percentage of the total births per quarter, babies born to teenage mothers show an increase of 0.2%.

Figure 3 Immigration trend by nationality and place of birth, 2002-2006 (absolute)





Figure 4 Emigration trend by nationality and place of birth, 2002-2006 (absolute)



Migration trends

In 1996 Aruba experienced its highest influx of migration; a total of 4,950 persons registered at the Population registry Office. Since, the migration has been more or less steady at about 3,469 immigrants a year. In 2004 there is a peak in the number of immigrants again with 3,858 persons. In 2005 there is a slight drop in the migrating population. In 2006 however the immigrants dropped to only 2,372 persons, 37% less than in 2006. The foreign population experienced the greatest drop in numbers, from being about 44% of all the migrants in 2006 they accounted for only 26%. In absolute numbers the foreign born migrants dropped with 59% less than in 2005.

The Dutch born in Aruba/ Netherlands Antilles and the Netherlands also show a slight drop in the numbers arriving to Aruba. About a quart less are migrating to Aruba.

Emigration, contrary to immigration shows an increasing trend. After some years of constant decrease in the number of persons leaving the island, the numbers are showing some upward movement. In 2006, 17.2% more persons left than in 2006. However, the persons leaving are in greater number the 'locals'.
