




## Quarterly Demographic Bulletin

- The net growth of the population is slowing down, as the population totals 105,469 persons by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2008. During the nineties the population's growth rate averaged 35 per thousand persons a year. During these first 8 years of the new millennium, the growth rate is at an average of 16 per thousand persons.
- The number of children aged 0 thru 14 years is steadily decreasing while the group of 60 plus is steadily increasing. At the beginning of the new millennium the share of the youth was 23 percent of the total population, by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter 2008 they account for less than 20 percent of the population.
- As for the elderly population aged 60+ their share is constantly increasing, from being 11 percent of the total population in 2000 to 14 percent by the end of September 2008. During the nineties their share was between 10 and 11 percent.

- The majority of registered babies for the first 3 quarters of 2008 were born to mothers aged 20-24 years of age compared to the majority being born to mothers aged 25-29 years in the previous years.
- 11 percent of the registered babies were born to a teenage mother.
- One of every 4 persons who passed away during the last seven years was younger than 60 years. The average age at death was about 68 years. The median age of the deceased persons was 72 years.
- The average age at death for men was 65 years, while the average age at death for women was 72 years.
- The crude death rate is about 5 per 1,000 during the last seven years.

## Quarterly Demographic Bulletin

- A total of 2,147 persons registered at the Population Registry Office by the end of the 3<sup>rd</sup> quarter of 2008; which almost equals the total of persons registering during 2007.
- The average age at registering is 24 for the Dutch born in Aruba/Neth.Ant., where the women register at a younger age than men. Respectively 23 for men and 24 for women.
- The average age of Dutch women born in the Netherlands registering was 26 years, while the Dutch men born in the Netherlands was 27.
- Persons registering coming from other foreign countries are on average 35 years of age, both men and women.
- Usually more women migrate to Aruba then men. During the third quarter of both 2007 and 2008 there were more men who migrated to Aruba than women.
