

Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006 October 2010

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of October 2010.

The CPI for October 2010 is 113.89, a decrease of 0.51% compared to the index of September 2010 (114.47) and accumulating a decline of 1.13% up to and including October of this year.

The percentage change of the CPI over the last 12 months (October 2009 to October 2010) is -0.59, an increase of 2.67 percentage points (ppts) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (-3.26).

The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period October 2009 - October 2010 is 2.89, an increase of 5.51 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period October 2008 - October 2009 (-2.62).

During this month, eight of the twelve sectors registered decreases in prices. The decrease which had the greatest influence on the CPI was registered for the "Housing" (-1.76%) sector, causing an effect of -0.52 ppts. The decreases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of -0.04 ppts on the CPI of October 2010.

Aforementioned decreases were partially offset by increases in the indices for the "Recreation and culture" (0.45%) and "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" (0.12%) sectors, with an influence of respectively 0.04 and 0.02 ppts. The increases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of 0.01 ppt on the CPI of October 2010.

The decrease in the "Housing" sector was due to decreases in the categories "Water supply and miscellaneous services relating to the dwelling" (-4.57%) and "Electricity, gas and other fuels" (-3.04%), which contributed to an effect of respectively -0.28 and -0.29 ppts.

The increase in the "Recreation and culture" sector was mainly due to a rise of 6.58% in the category "Holidays", which contributed to an effect of 0.04 ppts. The increase in the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector was mainly due to an increase in the category "Food" (0.12%), contributing with an effect of 0.01 ppt.

The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to September 2010, 35.0% of these products had an increase in price, while 32.5% showed a decrease and the remaining 32.5% had no change in price. The prices of goods decreased by 0.92% and caused an influence of -0.60 ppts. The prices of services show an increase of 0.27% and had an influence of 0.09 ppts.

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect energy and food - registered in October 2010 an increase of 0.23%, which is 2.80 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.03%). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel - registered an increase of 17.37%, which is 41.18 ppts higher compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (-23.81%). The food index shows a decrease of 3.05%, which is 10.41 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (7.36%).



Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in October 2010

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In October 2010 the average price of crude oil per barrel (US\$ 79.32) increased by US\$ 4.54 (6.07%) compared to September 2010 (US\$ 74.78).

Fuel surcharge shows in October a decrease of Afl. 1.37 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water show also decreases in price compared to September 2010. The average electricity price per household decreased to Afl. 308.72 (-3.12%) causing an effect of -0.29 ppts on the CPI, while the average price of water per household decreased to Afl. 153.95 (-5.12%) causing an effect of -0.28 ppts on the CPI.

In October 2010 the price of gasoline decreased by Afl. 0.01 (-0.58%) causing an effect of -0.03 ppts on the CPI. The price of diesel registered an insignificant increase (0.80%) in October 2010.

In October 2010, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show a decrease in price of 2.90% compared to September 2010, and had an influence of -0.60 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced an increase in price of 0.11%, causing an effect of 0.09 ppts on the CPI.
