

Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006 October 2012

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of October 2012.

The CPI for October 2012 is 119.26, a decrease of 0.09% compared to the index of September 2012 (119.38) and accumulating a decrease of 1.72% up to and including October of this year.

The percentage change of the CPI over the last 12 months (October 2011 to October 2012) is -1.64, a decrease of 8.11 percentage points (ppts) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (6.47).

The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period October 2011 - October 2012 is 2.19, a decrease of 1.05 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period October 2010 - October 2011 (3.24).

During this month, five of the twelve sectors registered decreases in prices. The decrease which had the greatest influence on the CPI was registered for the "Recreation and culture" sector (-0.66%), causing an effect of -0.06 ppts. The decreases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of -0.08 ppts on the CPI of October 2012.

Aforementioned decreases were partially offset mainly by an increase in the index for the "Transport" sector (0.10%), which had an influence of 0.02 ppts. The increases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of 0.02 ppts on the CPI of October 2012.

The decrease in the "Recreation and culture" sector was mainly due to a decrease in the category "Audio-visual, photographic and information processing equipment" (-3.81%), which contributed to an effect of -0.04 ppts.

The increase in the "Transport" sector was mainly caused by an increase of 2.03% in the category "Transport services", which contributed to an effect of 0.03 ppts.

The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to September 2012, 32.5% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 0.27 ppts, while 33.2% showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -0.37 ppts and the remaining 34.3% had no change in price. The prices of goods decreased by 0.19% and caused an influence of -0.12 ppts. The prices of services show an increase of 0.09% and had an influence of 0.03 ppts.

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food - registered in October 2012 an increase of 0.57%, which is 0.56 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (1.13%). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel - registered an increase of 6.44%, which is 3.85 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (10.29%). The food index shows an increase of 3.67%, which is 0.34 ppts higher compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.33%).



Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in October 2012

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In October 2012 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 90.08) had a decrease of US\$ 4.49 (-4.75%) compared to September 2012 (US\$ 94.57).

Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity up to 500 kWh surcharge did not change in October 2012, it stayed at Afl. 32.49 cents per kWh. Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity above 500 kWh surcharge did not change either in October 2012, it stayed at Afl. 38.47 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to September 2012. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 363.27, while the average price of water per household remained at Afl. 137.05.

In October 2012 insignificant increases of 0.08% and 1.73% were registered for the prices of gasoline and diesel respectively, causing together an effect of 0.01 ppt on the CPI.

In October 2012, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show an increase in price of 0.05% compared to September 2012, and had an influence of 0.01 ppt on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of 0.13%, causing an effect of -0.11 ppts on the CPI.

Change in prices of Food & catering services in October 2012

The "Food & catering services" index decreased with 0.15% in October 2012 after increasing 0.23% in September 2012. The index for "Food at home" shows a decrease of 0.19% in October, as four of the eleven "Food at home" indices decreased in October 2012. The "Potatoes and other tubers" index registered the largest decrease (-6.43%) in October and was caused by a decrease in the index for "Potatoes" (-8.42%). The "Vegetables" index decreased by 1.84%, after increasing 2.41% the previous month. The index for "Bread and cereals" shows a decrease of 0.58%. The index for "Milk, cheese and eggs" decreased by 0.17%, its seventh consecutive decrease. The "Sugar, jam, honey and other confectionery" index increased the most (0.62%), followed by increases of 0.54%, 0.38% and 0.30% in the indices for "Food products n.e.c.", "Meat" and "Fruit", respectively.

Over the last 12 months the "Food & catering services" index has increased by 1.36%. The "Food at home" index shows an increase of 0.51%. The "Fish and other seafood" index increased by 6.09%, the largest increase among the "Food at home" food groups, while the "Potatoes and other tubers" index (-14.09%) shows the largest decrease.

The index for "Food away from home" was unchanged in October 2012, after increasing 0.08% in September, and has increased by 4.42% over the last 12 months.

In October 2012, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group show a decrease in price of 0.15% compared to September 2012, and had an influence of -0.03 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of 0.08%, causing an effect of -0.07 ppts on the CPI.
