

Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006 January 2013

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of January 2013.

The CPI for January 2013 is 116.78, a decrease of 0.1% compared to the index of December 2012 (116.85).

The percentage change of the CPI over the last 12 months (January 2012 to January 2013) is -3.5, a decrease of 8.9 percentage points (ppts) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (5.4).

The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period January 2012 - January 2013 is -0.2, a decrease of 5.0 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period January 2011 - January 2012 (4.8).

During this month, six of the twelve sectors registered decreases in prices. The decreases which had the greatest influence on the CPI were registered for the "Clothing and footwear" sector (-2.3%) and the "Transport" sector (-0.4%), causing an effect of respectively -0.12 ppts and -0.08 ppts. The decreases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of -0.04 ppts on the CPI of January 2013.


Aforementioned decreases were partially offset mainly by increases in the index for the "Alcoholic beverages and tobacco" sector (8.5%) and the "Recreation and culture" (0.7%), which had an influence of respectively 0.08 ppts and 0.06 ppts. The increases in the remaining sectors had a total effect of 0.04 ppts on the CPI of January 2013.

The decrease in the "Clothing and footwear" sector was due to a decrease in the category "Clothing" (-2.6%), which contributed to an effect of -0.12 ppts. The decrease in the "Transport" sector was caused by decreases in the categories "Transport services" (-2.5%) and "Operation of personal transport equipment" (-0.4%), which together contributed to an effect of -0.08 ppts.

The increase in the "Alcoholic beverages and tobacco" sector was mainly caused by an increase of 24.6% in the category "Tobacco", which contributed to an effect of 0.07 ppts. The increase in the "Recreation and culture" sector was mainly due to an increase in the category "Holidays" (6.9%), which contributed to an effect of 0.05 ppts.

The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to December 2012, 34.7% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 0.42 ppts, while 35.2% showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -0.48 ppts and the remaining 30.1% had no change in price. The prices of goods decreased by 0.1% and caused an influence of -0.09 ppts. The prices of services show an increase of 0.1% and had an influence of 0.03 ppts.

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food - registered in January 2013 a decrease of 0.1%, which is 2.1 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (2.0%). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel - registered a decrease of 1.5%, which is 15.6 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (14.1%). The food index shows an increase of 2.0%, which is 2.9 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (4.9%).

Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in January 2013

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In January 2013 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 94.04) had an increase of US\$ 6.27 (7.1%) compared to December 2012 (US\$ 87.77).

Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity up to 500 kWh did not change in January 2013, it stayed at Afl. 24.60 cents per kWh. Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity between 501 - 1000 kWh did not change in January 2013, it stayed at Afl. 30.90 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to December 2012. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 306.75, while the average price of water per household remained at Afl. 137.05.

In January 2013 the price of gasoline decreased by Afl. 0.01 (-0.6%) causing an effect of -0.04 ppts on the CPI. In January 2013 an insignificant decrease of Afl. 0.01 (-0.6%) was registered for the price of diesel.

In January 2013, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show a decrease in price of 0.2% compared to December 2012, and had an influence of -0.04 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced a slight decrease in price, causing an effect of -0.01 ppt on the CPI.

Change in prices of Food & catering services in January 2013

The "Food & catering services" index increased by 0.1% in January 2013 after increasing 0.2% in December 2012. The index for "Food at home" shows an increase of 0.2% in January, as six of the eleven "Food at home" indices increased in January 2013. The "Vegetables" index registered the largest increase (2.4%) in January and was caused by increases of 8.0% and 3.9% in the indices for "Celery and broccoli" and "Onions", respectively. The "Fish and other seafood" index increased by 1.1%. The index for "Meat" shows an increase of 0.9% after declining in the two previous months. The index for "Sugar, jam, honey and other confectionery" shows an increase of 0.7%, its fourth consecutive increase. The "Potatoes and other tubers" index decreased the most (-3.9%), followed by decreases of 2.3% and 0.7% in the indices for "Fruit" and "Oils and fats", respectively.

Over the last 12 months the "Food & catering services" index has increased by 0.9%. The "Food at home" index shows an increase of 0.2%. The "Fish and other seafood" index increased by 5.2%, the largest increase among the "Food at home" food groups, while the "Potatoes and other tubers" index (-7.8%) shows the largest decrease.

The index for "Food away from home" decreased by 0.1% in January 2013, after being unchanged in December 2012, and has increased by 3.4% over the last 12 months.

In January 2013, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group show an increase in price of 0.1% compared to December 2012, and had an influence of 0.02 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of 0.1%, causing an effect of -0.08 ppts on the CPI.
