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
CONSUMER PRICE INDEX

Prices of water, electricity and gasoline

Prices of electricity (brandstofclausule included) and water remained unchanged in March 2008, compared to February 2008. Gasoline price increased by 2.2 percent compared to the previous month, reaching the amount of Afl. 2.18 per liter. In addition, price of diesel rose by 4.5 percent compared to February 2008, after dropping 0.6 percent in the corresponding period one month earlier. Diesel price reached an average price of Afl. 2.00 per liter in March 2008.




Disregarding any other important fluctuations in prices over the month of April 2008, price movements of gasoline during the month of April will affect the consumer price index of April 2008 by 0.16 percent.

UTILITIES


Water distribution down by 0.5 percent

Average water distribution (houses, companies, hotels, government) declined by 0.5 percent in March 2008, when compared to March 2007. This is mainly caused by a drop of 5.3 percent in the distribution to households. In addition, water distribution to the public sector dropped by 40.8 percent compared to March 2007. On the other hand, water distribution to hotels and companies increased by 14.6 and 0.7 percent respectively compared to March 2007.

Electricity distribution down by 2.0 percent

In March 2008, electricity (in MWh) supplied to Elmar for distribution dropped by 2.0 percent compared to March 2007. In the first quarter of 2008, average electricity distribution declined by 0.3 percent compared to the similar period of 2007.



FOREIGN TRADE

Imports of merchandise to Aruba up by 4.7 percent


In March 2008, total value of imports of merchandise increased by 4.7 percent compared to March 2007, after a 15.5 percent drop registered during the similar period one year earlier. This growth in March 2008 can be attributed to an expansion in the value of import of metal products, machinery & equipment (18.6%), mainly as a result of increases in the imports of watches (pocket-wrist-stop-other and parts) and parts of machinery & mecanical tools. Furthermore, value of import of agriculture products increased by 13.2 percent, mainly as a result of a growth in the imports of liquor and other distilled beverages.


In the January to March period of 2008, total import increased by 5.3 percent compared to the similar period of 2007. This is mainly caused by a growth in the imports of metal products, machinery & equipment (15.8%) and agriculture products (18.9%).


Total exports down by 28.3 percent

Total exports in March 2008 dropped by 28.3 percent compared to March 2007. This drop is mainly caused by a decline in the value of export of agriculture products (30.4%), metal products, machinery & equipment (33.7%), mineral, chemical & related products (25.9%) and textiles, pearls & precious stones (63.9%). On year to date basis, total export in March increased by 6.3 percent compared to the similar period of 2007.

TOURISM


Cruise tourism increased by 29.0 percent

In March 2008, cruise ship passenger arrivals increased by 29.0 percent compared to March 2007. The number of cruise calls grew by 14.0 percent compared to the same month of the previous year. In the January-to-March period of 2008, total number of cruise passengers is running 106.1 percent above the level registered during to the similar period of 2007.

Hotel statistics for the month of March 2008


The hotel industry performed better in March 2008, compared to the same period of 2007. Occupancy rate in hotels was at 85.8 percent, indicating an increase of 4.3 percent compared to March 2007. Room nights rented and the revenue per available room increased by 18.2 and 7.6 percent respectively, compared to March 2007.


