In 2013 1,154 babies were registered, 560 persons passed away, 3,335 persons registered themselves at the Population Registry Office and 2,291 others de-registered, totaling 106,795 persons at the end of the year.

- Overall, fewer couples are tying the knot. In 1999 a total of 913 couples married, of whom at least one partner was a resident of Aruba. As of the end of 2013, 523 couples married.
- The marriage rate in 2013 is nearly half of what it was in 2001, when it reached its highest ever during the last three decades.

Even as the overall number of marriages is declining, the most noteworthy decline is in the number of residents who choose to marry abroad

- The number of resident marriages that took place abroad was about 40 percent of all resident marriages in 1999. In 2013 this was equal to 22 percent, a drop of 64.5 percentage points.
- Aruban-born men are more prone to marry a foreign-born partner than Aruban-born women to marry a foreign-born partner.

- During the 2010 Census 16,158 married couples were counted. Of which 48.1% were partners both born in Aruba, 25.4% both partners were foreign-born, in 18.9% of all cases, the male partner was born in Aruba and in 7.6% of all cases, the female partner was born in Aruba.

- In 2010, the divorce rate among couples where both partners were Aruban-born was 1.8%. This was a slight decrease when compared to the year 2000 where the number of divorces of Aruban-born couples accounted for 2.1% of the total number of marriages between Aruban-born partners.

- Where both partners were foreign-born, the number of divorces accounted for 2.6% in 2010 compared to and 0.5% in 2000.

- The highest divorce rate was observed among couples where one of the partners was born in Aruba. The divorce rate of couples where the female partner was born in Aruba was 5.5% in 2010, compared to 0.2% in 2000. When the male partner was Aruban-born, the divorce rate was 4.6% in 2010, compared to 5.6% in 2000.
