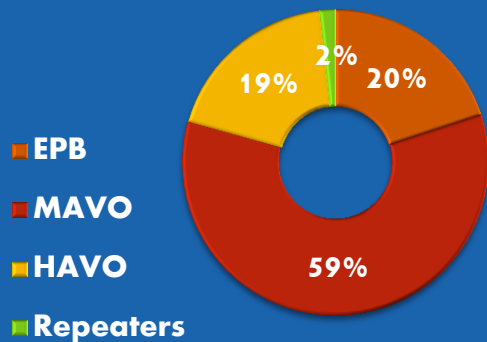

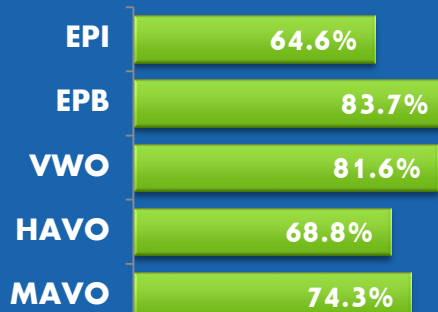

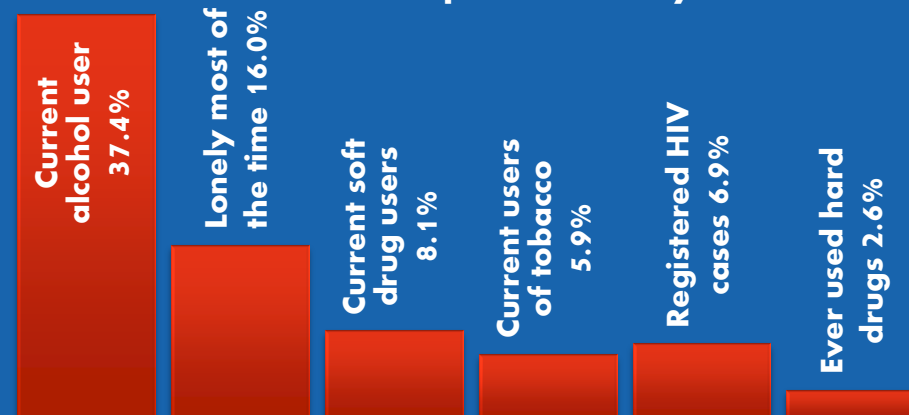
Education followed after 6th grade 2009-2013:



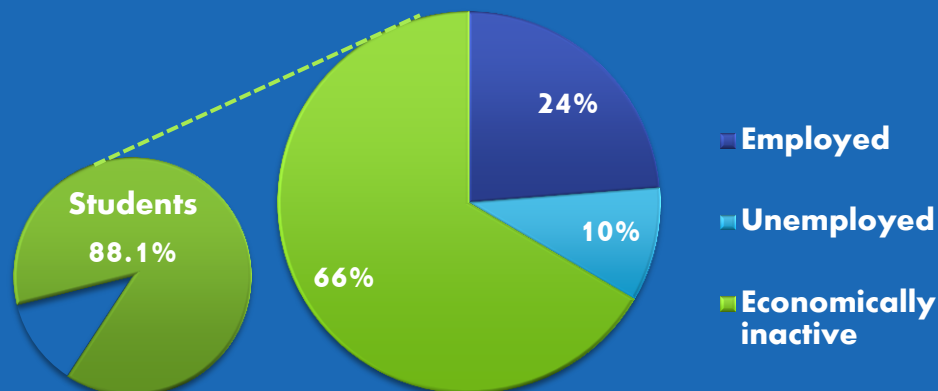
Final examination results 2012/2013:



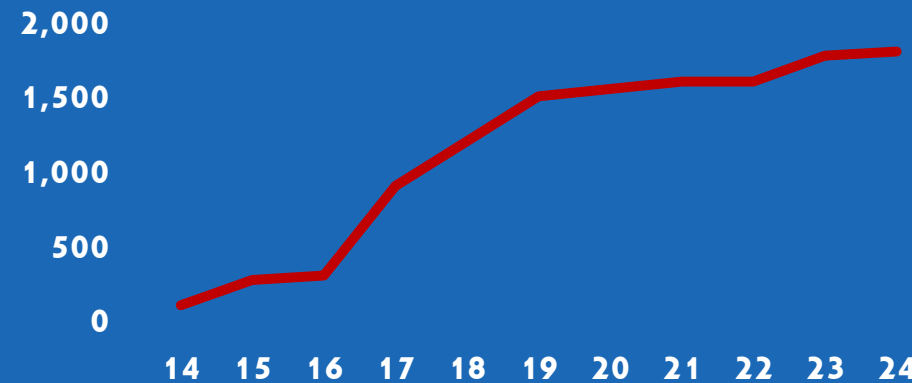
Health aspects of 12-19 year olds, 2012:
