

## Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006 July 2016

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of July 2016.

The CPI for July 2016 is 117.82, an increase of 0.3% compared to the index of June 2016 (117.44) and accumulating a decrease of 0.5% for the year 2016 up to and including July.

The percentage change of the CPI over the last twelve (12) months (July 2015 to July 2016) is -1.1%, a decrease of 2.0 percentage points (ppt) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (0.9%).

The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period July 2015 - July 2016 is -0.8%, a decrease of 1.8 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period July 2014 - July 2015 (1.0%).

During this month, seven (7) of the twelve (12) sectors registered increases in prices. The increases which had the greatest influence on the CPI were registered for the "Transport" (1.2%), "Recreation and culture" (2.1%) and "Household operation" (0.3%) sectors, causing an effect of 0.21, 0.17 and 0.02 ppts, respectively. The increases in the remaining sectors had an effect of 0.01 ppt on the CPI of July 2016.

Aforementioned increases were partially offset mainly by a decrease in the index for the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" (-0.5%), which had an influence of -0.08 ppts on the CPI of July 2016. The decreases in the remaining sectors had an effect of -0.01 ppt on the CPI of July 2016.

The increase in the "Transport" sector was caused by increases of 11.5% and 0.5% in the categories "Transport services" and ""Operation of personal transport equipment"", which contributed to an effect of 0.16 and 0.05 ppts, respectively. The increase in the "Recreation and culture" sector was mainly due to an increase in the category "Holidays" (13.3%), which contributed to an effect of 0.10 ppts. The increase in the "Household operation" sector was mainly due to an increase in the category "Household appliances" (3.2%), which contributed to an effect of 0.02 ppts.

The decrease in the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector was caused by a decrease of 0.6% in the category "Food", which contributed to an effect of -0.08 ppts. The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to June 2016, 28.5% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 0.58 ppts, while 29.4% showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -0.25 ppts and the remaining 42.0% had no change in price. The prices of goods increased by 0.1% and caused an influence of 0.05 ppts. The prices of services show an increase of 0.7% and had an influence of 0.28 ppts on the CPI of July 2016.

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food — was 0.8% in July 2016, which is 0.3 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (1.1%). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel — is -6.4%, which is 5.8 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (-0.6%). The food index shows a decrease of 0.3%, which is 4.0 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.7%).

The subsistence level for a household consisting of two (2) adults and two (2) children (aged 0-14 years) in July 2016 is Afl. 4,342, while for a single adult household it is Afl. 2,068.



## Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in July 2016

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In July 2016 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 45.24) had a decrease of US\$ 3.71 (7.6%) compared to June 2016 (US\$ 48.95).

Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity up to 500 kWh did not change in July 2016, it stayed at Afl. 21.90 cents per kWh. Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity between 501 - 1000 kWh did not change in July 2016, it stayed at Afl. 27.80 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to June 2016. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 308.76, while the average price of water per household remained at Afl. 137.05.

In July 2016 the price of gasoline increased by Afl. 1.40 cents (0.8%) causing an effect of 0.04 ppts on the CPI. The price of diesel registered an increase of Afl. 3.60 cents (2.6%) and had an effect of 0.01 ppt on the CPI of July 2016.

In July 2016, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show an increase in price of 0.3% compared to June 2016, and had an influence of 0.05 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced an increase of 0.3% in price, causing an effect of 0.28 ppts on the CPI.

## Change in prices of Food & catering services in July 2016

The "Food & catering services" index shows a decrease of 0.4% in July 2016, after an increase of 0.3% in June 2016. The index for "Food at home" shows a decrease of 0.5% in July, as nine (9) of the eleven (11) "Food at home" indices decreased in July 2016. The "Vegetables", "Fish and other seafood" and "Fruit" indices registered the largest decrease (-1.3%) in July 2016. Furthermore, decreases were posted in the indices for "Potatoes and other tubers" (0.9%), "Meat" (0.9%) and "Oils and fats" (0.6%). The "Food products n.e.c." index registered the largest increase (0.2%). Furthermore, an increase of 0.1% was posted in the index for "Non-alcoholic beverages".

Over the last twelve (12) months the "Food & catering services" index has decreased by 0.2%. The "Food at home" index shows a decrease of 0.7%. The "Fruit" index increased by 6.0%, the largest increase among the "Food at home" food groups, while the "Milk, cheese and eggs" index shows the largest decrease (-7.6%).

The index for "Food away from home" was unchanged in July 2016, after an increase of 0.2% in June 2016 and has increased by 1.3% over the last twelve (12) months.

In July 2016, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group show a decrease in price of 0.4% compared to June 2016, and had an influence of -0.08 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced an increase in price of 0.5%, causing an effect of 0.40 ppts on the CPI.
