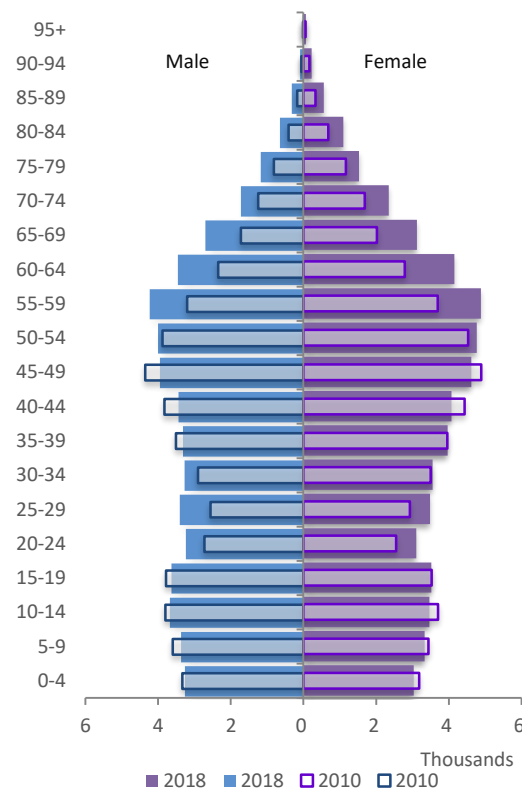

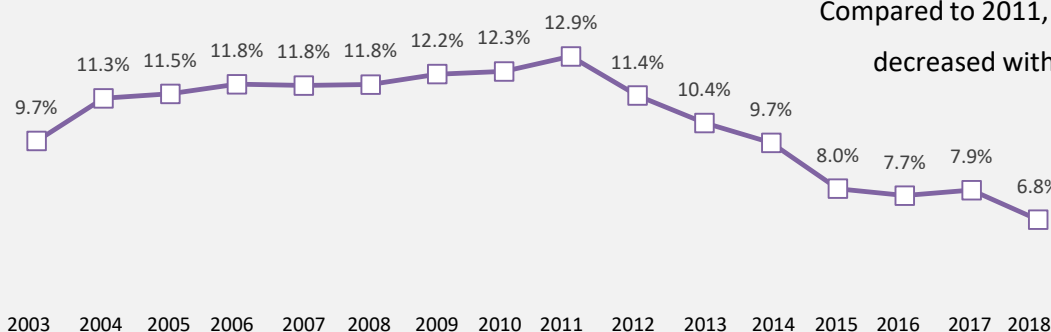

Graph 2. Births to teenage mothers as a percentage of all births, 2003-2018

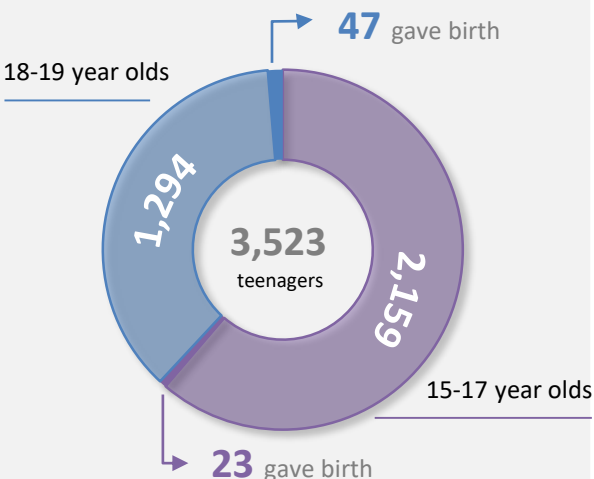


Compared to 2011, births to teenage mothers decreased with **56.3%** in 2018

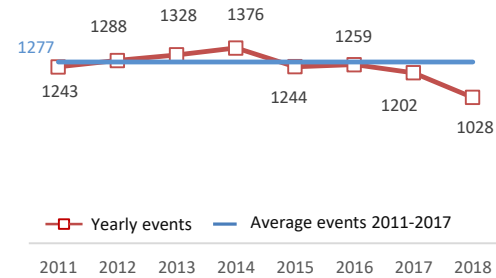

Graph 5. Deaths 2018 and 2011-2017 avg

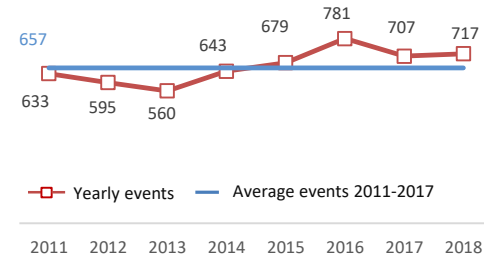

Graph 6. Domiciliation 2018 and 2011-2017 avg

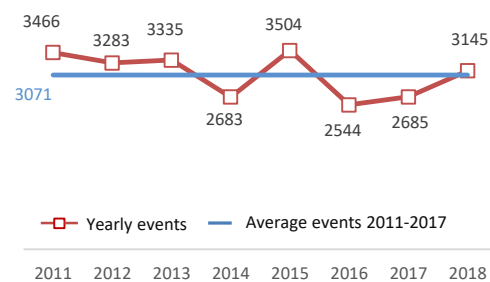

Graph 7. Departures 2018 and 2011-2017 avg

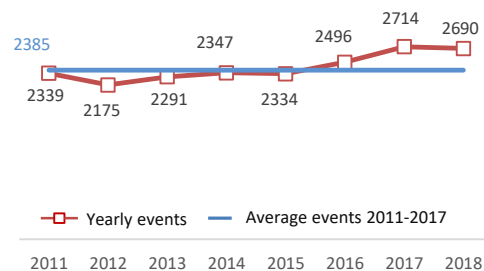

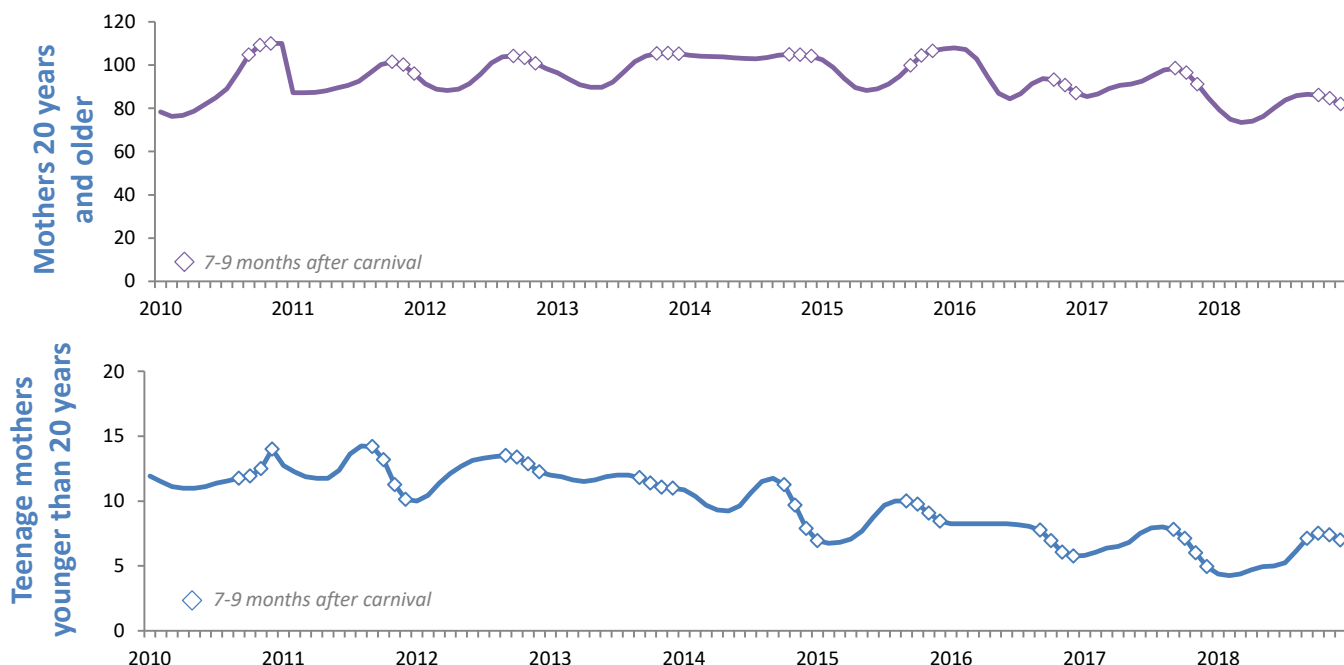

The smoothing technique was applied in graph 8. The purpose of smoothing is to highlight the general trend of the data and suppress high frequency oscillations. Due to the small number of births per month it's difficult to highlight any seasonality without using the smoothing technique.
