

Foreign Trade, Second Quarter 2021

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Foreign Trade of the 2nd quarter 2021.

Total Import

The total import, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 97.3% in the second quarter of 2021 (153.1 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2020 (77.6 mln kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total import increased by 56.9%, from Afl. 310.2 mln to Afl. 486.8 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 97.4% in the second quarter of 2021 (151.0 mln kg), compared to the same period in 2020 (76.5 mln kg). During this period, seventeen (17) of the twenty-one (21) sections registered increases in terms of weight in import to the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Mineral products" (66.3 mln. kg), "Food products" (3.7 mln. kg), "Live animals and other animal products" (1.3 mln. kg), "Vegetable products" (0.9 mln. kg) and "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (0.8 mln. kg).

The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" (-0.5 mln. kg), "Artificial plastic elements" (-0.3 mln. kg) and "Chemical products" (-0.1 mln. kg).

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (value)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 52.3% in the second quarter of 2021 (Afl. 461.0 mln) compared to the same period in 2020 (Afl. 302.7 mln). All twenty-one (21) sections registered increases in terms of value in import to the free circulation area of Aruba.

The largest increases are observed for the sections "Food products" (Afl. 24.5 mln), "Live animals and other animal products" (Afl. 17.1 mln.), "Transport equipment" (Afl. 14.8 mln), "Optical instruments, apparatus and equipment" (Afl. 14.3 mln) and "Chemical products" (Afl. 13.9 mln).

The abovementioned Import (to the free calculation area of Aruba) is the result of Import by Sea and Import by Air, which had the following developments:

1. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Sea

Import by Sea to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 97.5% in the second quarter of 2021 (150.5 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2020 (76.2 mln kg), while, in terms of value, the import by Sea increased by 41.2% from Afl. 261.5 mln to Afl. 369.3 mln.

2. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Air

Import by Air to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, increased by 77.2% from 0.4 mln kg in the second quarter of 2020 to 0.6 mln kg in the second quarter of 2021, while, in terms of value, the import by Air increased by 122.6% from Afl. 41.2 mln to Afl. 91.7 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* by Large companies**

Import by "Large companies", in terms of weight, increased by 25.9% from 16.8 mln kg in the second quarter of 2020 to 21.2 mln kg in the second quarter of 2021, while, in terms of value, it decreased by 17.1% from Afl. 47.4 mln to Afl. 39.3 mln.

Total Export

The total export, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 61.8% in the second quarter of 2021 (6.7 mln kg) compared to the same period of 2020 (4.2 mln kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total export increased by 128.7% from Afl. 21.0 mln to Afl. 48.1 mln.

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 40.4% in the second quarter of 2021 (4.7 mln kg) compared to the same period in 2020 (3.4 mln kg). Eleven (11) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered increases in terms of weight in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" (0.7 mln. kg), "Materials for the manufacture of paper, paperwork" (0.4 mln. kg), "Transport equipment" (0.3 mln. kg) and "Food products" (0.2 mln. kg).

The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" (-0.1 mln kg), "Artificial plastic elements" (-0.1 mln kg) and "Works of art, collectors pieces and antiques" (-0.1 mln kg).

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba* (value)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 93.3% in the second quarter of 2021 (Afl. 20.1 mln) compared to the same period in 2020 (Afl. 10.4 mln). Sixteen (16) of the twenty-one (21) sections, registered increases in terms of value in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Real pearls (natural) and other precious stones" (Afl. 3.4 mln), "Skins, hides, leather and peltry" (Afl. 1.6 mln), "Optical instruments, apparatus and equipment" (Afl. 1.5 mln) and "Transport equipment" (Afl. 1.5 mln).

The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Artificial plastic elements" (Afl. -0.2 mln), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (Afl. -0.1 mln) and "Vegetable products" (Afl. -0.1 mln).


