

Foreign Trade, 2021

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Foreign Trade of 2021.

Total Import

The total import, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 9.0% in 2021 (542.5 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (497.6 mln. kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total import registered an increase of 24.5%, from Afl. 1,681.8 mln. to Afl. 2,093.9 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 8.4% in 2021 (534.1 mln. kg), compared to 2020 (492.6 mln. kg). During 2021, fifteen (15) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of weight, registered increases in import to the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Mineral products" (28.2 mln. kg), "Food products" (5.8 mln. kg), "Miscellaneous manufactured articles" (4.1 mln. kg) and "Live animals and other animal products" (3.0 mln. kg).

The largest decreases are seen for the sections "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" (-2.8 mln. kg), "Chemical products" (-1.5 mln. Kg) and "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (-1.2 mln. Kg).

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba (value)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 22.0% in 2021 (Afl. 1,983.7 mln.) compared to 2020 (Afl. 1,626.3 mln.). During 2021, nineteen (19) of the twentyone (21) sections, in terms of value, registered increases in import to the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Food products" (Afl. 60.0 mln.), "Live animals and other animal products" (Afl. 53.5 mln.), "Chemical products" (Afl. 33.7 mln.) and "Real pearls (natural) and other precious stones" (Afl. 30.4 mln.).

The only decreases are seen for the sections "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (Afl. -31.4 mln.) and "Arms and ammunition" (Afl. -0.2 mln.).

Import to the free Zone of Aruba

Import to the free Zone of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 68.8% in 2021 (8.4 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (5.0 mln. kg), while, in terms of value, it increased by 98.8% from Afl. 55.4 mln. to Afl. 110.2 mln.

The abovementioned import (to the free circulation area of Aruba) is the result of Import by Sea and Import by Air, which had the following effects:

1. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Sea

Import by sea to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 8.4% in 2021 (531.1 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (490.1 mln. kg), and in terms of **value**, the import by Sea registered an increase of 19.1%, from Afl. 1,359.0 mln. to Afl. 1,619.0 mln.

2. Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Air


Import by air to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 20.4% in 2021 (3.1 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (2.5 mln. kg), while, in terms of **value**, the import by Air increased by 36.4%, from Afl. 267.4 mln. to Afl. 364.7 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Large companies**

Import by "Large companies", in terms of **weight**, increased by 8.7%, from 83.4 mln. kg in 2020 to 90.6 mln. kg in 2021, while, in terms of **value**, it decreased by 10.3%, from Afl. 188.5 mln. to Afl. 169.1 mln.

Total Export

Total export from Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 49.6% in 2021 (29.2 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (19.5 mln. mln. kg), while, in terms of **value**, it increased by 34.0% from Afl. 118.0 mln. to Afl. 158.1 mln.

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba (weight)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 39.9% in 2021 (21.6 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (15.4 mln. kg). During 2021, fifteen (15) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of weight, registered increases in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" (3.7 mln. kg), "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" (1.5 mln. kg) and "Materials for the manufacture of paper, paperwork" (1.2 mln. kg).

The largest decrease is seen for the section "Food products" (-0.4 mln. kg). Furthermore, a decrease of -0.1 mln. kg was registered for the sections "Works of art, collector's pieces and antiques", "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" and "Artificial plastic elements".

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba (value)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered a decrease of 4.2% in 2021 (Afl. 58.8 mln.) compared to 2020 (Afl. 61.4 mln.). During 2021, ten (10) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of value, registered decreases in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Optical instruments, apparatus and equipment" (Afl. -2.5 mln.), "Real pearls (natural) and other precious stones" (Afl. -1.4 mln.), "Footwear, headgear and umbrellas" (Afl. -1.2 mln.) and "Base metals and derivated works" (Afl. -0.7 mln.).

The largest increase is seen for the section "Skins, hides, leather and peltry" (Afl. 1.3 mln.). Furthermore, increases of Afl. 0.8 mln. and Afl. 0.7 mln. were registered for the sections "Works of art, collector's pieces and antiques" and "Transport equipment", respectively.

Export from the free Zone of Aruba

Export from the free Zone of Aruba, in terms of weight, registered an increase of 86.1% in 2021 (7.6 mln. kg) compared to 2020 (4.1 mln. kg), while, in terms of value, it increased by 75.4% from Afl. 56.6 mln. to Afl. 99.3 mln.
