Consumer Price Index, base period June 2019

November 2022

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of November 2022.

Consumer Price Index for the month of November 2022

The CPI for November 2022 is 106.49, an increase of 0.2% compared to the index of October 2022 (106.30) and accumulating an increase of 5.8% up to and including November of this year.

The percentage change of the CPI over the last twelve (12) months (November 2021 to November 2022) is 6.6, an increase of 3.5 percentage points (ppts) compared to the percentage change for the same period of the previous year (3.1%).

The period average (last 24 months) percentage change of the CPI for the periods November 2020 to November 2021 and November 2021 to November 2022 is 5.3%, an increase of 5.1 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the periods November 2019 to November 2020 and November 2020 to November 2021 (0.2%).

During this month, eight (8) of the twelve (12) sectors registered increases in prices. The increases that had the greatest influence on the CPI were registered for the "Transport" (2.2%) and "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" (1.7%) sectors, which contributed with an effect of 0.31 and 0.20 ppts, respectively. The increases in the remaining sectors had an effect of 0.35 ppts on the CPI of November 2022.

Aforementioned increases were partially offset mainly by a decrease in the index for the "Communications" (-6.5%) sector, causing an effect of -0.51 ppts. The decreases in the remaining sectors had an effect of -0.17 ppts on the CPI of November 2022.

The increase in the "Transport" sector was mainly due to an increase in the category "Operation of personal transport equipment" (3.0%), which contributed to an effect of 0.25 ppts. The increase in the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector was mainly due to an increase of 1.8% in the category "Food", which contributed to an effect of 0.18 ppts.

The decrease in the "Communications" sector was mainly due to a decrease in the category "Telephone and telefax services" (-6.8%), which contributed to an effect of -0.51 ppts.

Consumption basket

The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 408 goods and services. Compared to October 2022, 52.7% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 1.40 ppts, while 33.1% showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -1.22 ppts and the remaining 14.2% had no change in price. The prices of goods increased by 1.4% and caused an influence of 0.82 ppts. The prices of services decreased by 1.6% and had an influence of -0.64 ppts on the CPI of November 2022.

Core inflation

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food – was 3.0% in November 2022. The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel – was 13.5%. The food index showed an increase of 9.7%.

Subsistence level

The subsistence level for a household consisting of two (2) adults and two (2) children (aged 0-14 years) in November 2022 is Afl. 5,362, an increase of Afl. 466 compared to November 2021 (Afl. 4,896). The subsistence level for a single adult household is Afl. 2,553, an increase of Afl. 222 compared to November 2021 (Afl. 2,331).

Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in November 2022

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In November 2022 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 85.08) had a decrease of US\$ 2.53 (-2.9%) compared to October 2022 (US\$ 87.61).

The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to October 2022. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 294.56, while the average price of water per household remained at Afl. 168.73.

In November 2022 the price of gasoline registered an increase of Afl. 14.20 cents (5.6%) and had an effect of 0.27 ppts on the CPI. The price of diesel registered an increase of Afl. 25.40 cents (9.8%) and had an effect of 0.04 ppts on the CPI of November 2022.

In November 2022, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group showed an increase in price of 1.7% compared to October 2022, and had an influence of 0.31 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 404 goods and services, as a group, show a decrease of 0.2% and had an effect of -0.14 ppts on the CPI.

Change in prices of Food & catering services in November 2022

The "Food & catering services" index showed an increase of 1.4% in November 2022, after an increase of 0.7% in October 2022. The index for "Food at home" showed an increase of 1.7% in November, as ten (10) of the eleven (11) "Food at home" indices increased in November 2022. The "Vegetables" index registered the largest increase (5.9%) in November 2022. Furthermore, other significant increases were posted in the indices for "Milk, cheese and eggs" (3.8%), "Bread and cereals" (1.7%), "Oils and fats" (1.5%), "Meat" (1.1%) and "Non-alcoholic beverages" (1.1%).

The only decrease was registered in the index of "Potatoes and other tubers" (-1.5%).

Over the last twelve (12) months, the "Food & catering services" has increased by 10.9%. The "Food at home" index showed an increase of 12.7%, where all of the "Food at home" indices increased over the last year. The "Oils and fats" index increased by 18.4%, the largest increase among the "Food at home" food groups. Furthermore, other significant increases were posted in the indices for "Milk, cheese and eggs" (17.2%), "Meat" (16.5%), "Potatoes and other tubers" (14.4%), "Fish and other seafood" (14.4%), "Bread and cereals" (12.5%) and "Non-alcoholic beverages" (11.8%).

The index for "Food away from home" increased by 0.7% in November 2022 and has increased by 6.5% over the last twelve (12) months.

In November 2022, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group showed an increase in price of 1.4% compared to October 2022, and had an influence of 0.23 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of 0.1%, causing an effect of -0.05 ppts on the CPI.
