#### **Preface**

The Foreign Trade Statistics (FTS), first quarter 2022, publication contains information on Imports to Aruba, Imports to the Free Zone Aruba, Exports from Aruba and Exports from the Free Zone Aruba. Comparisons are made for the quarters of 2021 and 2022 and should still be considered as provisional.

Starting March 1 2014, the Customs Department implemented a new program that reformed the Customs clearance process, "ASYCUDA" (Automated SYstem for CUstoms DAtay). This is a computerized customs management system designed by UNCTAD to assist customs authorities all over the world to automate and control their core processes. This system takes into account the international Harmonized Commodity Description and coding System (generally referred to as "Harmonized System or simply "HS") and standards developed by ISO (International Organization for Standardization), WCO (World Customs Organization) and the United Nations. It also generates trade data that can be used for statistical economic analysis and which can support government projections and planning.

More than 170 countries and economies use the HS system as a basis for their Customs tariffs and for the collection of international trade statistics. Over 98 % of the merchandise in international trade is classified in terms of the HS. The Harmonized System comprises of 97 Chapters and is arranged in 21 Sections. Goods are arranged in the HS according to the increasing degree of manufacture: raw materials, unworked products, semi-finished products, finished products. The HS is a universal economic language and coding system for goods, and an indispensable tool for international trade (Statistics).

Since January 2009, the CBS has been processing trade data according to the Harmonized System. In order to facilitate comparisons over time, a link was established between the ASYCUDA-classification and the Harmonized System. Since the introduction of the Harmonized system codification, in 2009, it became possible to publish, part of the mineral fuels import and export. Import of Crude oil and butane is excluded from the trade elements of mineral fuels. The export of crude oil, kerosene, gasoline, gas, propane and butane is also excluded from the trade elements of mineral fuels. Before 2009, all mineral fuels were excluded.

Special thanks goes to our data-supplier and supporter, namely the Customs Department.

For further inquiry on definitions and methodology, we refer to the Aruba Foreign Trade Statistics Procedure and Definitions, which is available upon request at the Central Bureau of Statistics.

#### A note to the reader

he following report presents the trade statistics for the first quarter of 2022.

- "Chapter 1.B Specific guidelines.2 Goods recommended for exclusion", section 1.51. "Goods under operating
  lease" of the publication "International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS), 2010", recommends that these
  goods should be excluded from the international merchandise trade statistics. For 2016 and on, the CBS has
  excluded these goods from its trade statistics.
- "Chapter 1.B Specific guidelines.1 Goods recommended for inclusion", section 1.51. "Migrants' effects" of the
  publication "International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS), 2010", recommends that these goods should
  be included in the international merchandise trade statistics. For 2015 and on, the CBS has recoded these
  goods.
- International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS) are well developed and international standards that have been defined in the IMTS 2010 to harmonize standards and practices. In order to comply with the harmonization of the partner attribution, the years 2018 up to 2021 were revised and corrected. IMTS recommends to record, in the case of imports, the country of origin (the country in which the goods have been produced or manufactured) as the partner country. The correct application of partner attribution by countries will contribite to improved international comparability of trade data. Previously, the country of consignment or provenance from which goods were dispatched was recorded as the country of origin.
- Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 40.5% in the first quarter of 2022 (Afl. 535.8 mln) compared to the same period in 2021 (Afl. 381.3 mln). During this period all twenty sections registered increases. The largest increase is seen in the section "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" (Afl. 21.8 mln), which was mainly caused by an increase in the category "Reactors, machinery and mechanical appliances" (Afl. 16.4 mln).
- Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of value, registered an increase of 14.3% in the first quarter of 2022 (Afl. 13.5 mln) compared to the same period in 2021 (Afl. 11.8 mln). The largest increase is seen for the section "Transport equipment" (Afl. 1.6 mln), which was mainly caused by a decrease in the category "Ships, boats and floating structures" (Afl. 1.3 mln).

This report is divided in 7 sections. An overview of the total imports and exports of goods to and from Aruba, by large and other companies, is presented in section A. Sections B and E provide the total imports and exports by "sections". The imports and exports by type of transportation and by region are indicated in sections C and F. Sections D and G present the total imports and exports by country and by sections.

#### **II. Explanatory Notes**

#### 1. Trade Data

The collection of data through Customs administration conform ASYCUDA is a computerized customs management system which covers most foreign trade procedures. The system handles manifests and customs declarations, accounting procedures, and warehousing manifest and suspense procedures. The program registers approximately 10.000 documents per month. In order to report findings on a timely basis, the CBS publishes preliminary quarterly data. The revised data will be published in the annual FTS publication.

#### 2. Trade Flows

CBS is utilizing the International General Trade System for the processing and publication of all import and export data by commodities and by country for the island of Aruba.<sup>1</sup>

There are two types of movements at the free zone: S9 for goods that arrive from abroad and are stored and E4 for goods exported from Aruba into the free zone. These goods leave the free zone either as a transit good (E8) or an import into Aruba (C48.). By definition, these transactions belong to the Special Trade as well as the General Trade. For many reasons, certain goods are excluded, such as monetary gold, securities, bank notes, coins in circulation and postal items; and goods consigned by a government to its armed forces and diplomatic representatives abroad including Embassies, Consulates, Kabinet van Nederlands-Antilliaanse en Arubaans Zaken (KABNA), Kabinet of the Governor and Marinierskazerne. These goods are excluded from the foreign trade statistics according to United Nations recommendations. Certain commodities are also excluded from this publication because of specific statistical thresholds or lack of data. Since the introduction of the Harmonized system codification, in 2009, it has become possible to publish part of the mineral fuels (category 27) import and export. Import of Crude oil and butane is excluded from the trade elements of mineral fuels. The export of crude oil, kerosene, gasoline, gas, propane and butane is also excluded from the trade elements of mineral fuels. Before 2009 all mineral fuels were excluded.

#### 3. Partner Countries

In the case of imports, the partner country<sup>2</sup> is the country of origin (the country in which the good were produced or manufactured). In the case of exports, the partner country is the country of final destination known at the time of dispatching the goods. The tables by country show the most important countries of the trade value by section for each transaction type for the current quarter. These top countries represent the total transactions by Section.

#### 4. Commodity and Country classification

The Harmonized System for Aruba covers 5914 eight digit commodity codes. The first two digits of the code are universally recognized product codes. The remaining six digits further divide the categories into the specific commodities. For publication purposes, Aruba uses 21 sections to clearly organize these product groups. Until December 2008, the Asycuda coding system was used by the Customs department of Aruba.

#### 5. Values and Quantities

The value of the goods equals the value of the commodity at the place and time it crosses the border. The basis for valuation is cost, insurance & freight (c.i.f.) for import and free on board (f.o.b.) for export. All values are in thousands of Aruban Florins (\$1=Afl. 1.79) (Vx1000 Afl) and quantities are expressed as net weight in thousands of kilos (Wx1000 kg). Blanks on values or quantities indicate that there was no transaction for that commodity code.

#### 6. Tables

Definitions of tables are shown in the upper left-hand corner of each table.

- <sup>1</sup> Total Imports and Total Exports include all goods entering or leaving the economic territory of Aruba, respectively. The economic territory of Aruba comprises Aruba (the free circulation area) and the Free Zone Aruba. This is consistent with the General Trade System.
- <sup>2</sup> In order to comply with the harmonization of the partner attribution (International Merchandise Trade Statistics (IMTS 2010)), from now on the country of origin (the country in which goods have been produced or manufactured) will be used instead of the country of consignment or provenance.
