

Foreign Trade, 2022

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Foreign Trade of 2022.

Total Import

The total import, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 54.7 mln. kg (9.8%), in 2022 (611.7 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (557.0 mln. kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total import registered an increase of Afl. 546.2 mln. (26.1%) from Afl. 2,092.5 mln. to Afl. 2,638.7 mln.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba* (weight)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 52.2 mln. kg (9.5%) in 2022 (600.5 mln. kg), compared to 2021 (548.4 mln. kg). During 2022, nineteen (19) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of **weight**, registered increases in import to the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Mineral products" 33.1 mln. Kg (10.9%), "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" 4.4 mln. Kg (24.8%) and "Food products" 3.5 mln. Kg (5.1%).

The only two (2) decreases are seen for the sections "Vegetable products" -1.6 mln. Kg (-4.0%) and "Fats and oils" -0.2 mln. Kg (-7.0%).

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba (value)

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **value**, registered an increase of Afl. 506.9 mln. (25.6%) in 2022 (Afl. 2,489.4 mln.) compared to 2021 (Afl. 1,982.5 mln.). During 2022, twenty (20) of the twenty one (21) sections, in terms of **value**, registered increases in import to the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" Afl. 80.7 mln. (32.2%), "Mineral products" Afl. 73.4 mln. (57.9%), "Transport equipment" Afl. 48.9 mln. (51.4%) and "Live animals and other animal products" Afl. 48.0 mln.(25.5%).

The only decrease is seen for the section "Chemical products" Afl. -1.2 mln. (-0.5%).

Import to the free Zone of Aruba

Import to the free Zone of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 2.5 mln. kg (29.1%) in 2022 (11.1 mln. kg) compared to 2021 8.6 mln. kg), and was mainly due to an increase of 2.6 mln. kg (31.7%) in the section "Food products". In terms of **value**, it increased by Afl. 39.2 mln (35.6%) from Afl. 110.1 mln. to Afl. 149.3 mln. and was mainly due to an increase of Afl. 40.8 mln. (38.2%) in the section "Food products".


The abovementioned import (to the free circulation area of Aruba) is the result of Import by Sea and Import by Air, which had the following effects:

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Sea

Import by sea to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 52.2 mln. kg (9.6%)in 2022 (597.5 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (545.3 mln. kg), and was mainly due to an increase of 33.1 mln. kg (10.9%) in the section "Mineral products". In terms of **value**, the import by Sea registered an increase of 441.5 mln. kg (27.3%), from Afl. 1,617.8 mln. to Afl. 2,059.3 mln. and was mainly due to increases of 73.4 mln. kg (57.9%) and 64.9 mln. kg (31.6%) in the sections "Mineral products" and "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)", respectively.

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Air

Import by air to the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered a decrease of 0.1 mln. kg (-3.2%) in 2022 (3.0 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (3.1 mln. kg) and was mainly due to a decrease of 0.1 mln. kg (-15.7) in the section "Vegetable products". In terms of **value**, the import by Air increased by 65.4 mln. kg (17.9%), from Afl. 364.6 mln. to Afl. 430.1 mln. and was mainly due to an increase of Afl. 32.2 mln. (57.4%) in the section "Real pearls (natural) and other precious stones".

Import to the free circulation area of Aruba by Large companies**

Import by "Large companies", in terms of **weight**, increased by 4.8 mln. kg (5.3%), from 90.7 mln. kg in 2021 to 95.5 mln. kg in 2022, and was mainly due to an increase of 4.6 mln. kg (5.2%) in the section "Mineral products". In terms of **value**, it increased by Afl. 88.0 mln. (52.0%), from Afl. 169.1 mln. to Afl. 257.1 mln. and was mainly due to an increase of Afl. 66.9 mln. (65.6%) in the section "Mineral products".

Total Export

Total export from Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered a slight increase of 0.004 mln. kg (0.01%), in 2022 (29.72 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (29.72 mln. kg), while, in terms of **value**, the total import registered an increase of Afl. 31.1 mln. (19.7%) from Afl. 157.8 mln. to Afl. 188.9 mln.

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba (weight)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered a decrease of 1.1 mln. kg (-5.2%) in 2022 (20.7 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (21.8 mln. kg). During 2021, fourteen (14) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of **weight**, registered decreases in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest decreases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" -1.2 mln. kg (-11.5%), "Works of stone, gypsum, cement, asbestos" -0.7 mln. kg (-42.9%) and "Materials for the manufacture of paper, paperwork" -0.3 mln. kg (-5.8%).

The largest increases are seen for the sections "Food products" 1.3 mln. kg (130.1%) and "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" 0.2 mln. kg (25.7%).

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba (value)

Export from the free circulation area of Aruba, in terms of **value**, registered an increase of Afl 10.2 mln. (17.4%) in 2022 (Afl. 69.0 mln.) compared to 2021 (Afl. 58.8 mln.). During 2022, eleven (11) of the twenty-one (21) sections, in terms of **value**, registered increases in the export from the free circulation area of Aruba. The largest increases are observed for the sections "Base metals and derivated works" Afl 8.1 mln. (125.2%), "Machinery & electrotechnical equipment (new & renewed)" Afl 3.3 mln. (62.5%) and "Food products" Afl 1.8 mln. (77.6%).


The largest decreases are seen for the sections "Chemical products" -Afl 2.5 mln. (-28.4%) and "Skins, hides, leather and peltry" Afl -1.6 mln. (-76.7%).

Export from the free Zone of Aruba

Export from the free Zone of Aruba, in terms of **weight**, registered an increase of 1.1 mln. kg (14.4%) in 2022 (9.0 mln. kg) compared to 2021 (7.9 mln. kg) and was mainly due to an increase of 1.2 mln. kg (15.4%) in the section "Food products". In terms of **value**, it increased by Afl. 20.9 mln. (21.1%) from Afl. 99.0 mln. to Afl. 119.9 mln. and was mainly due to an increase of Afl. 21.0 mln. (21.3%) in the section "Food products".


