

Foreign Trade Statistics, Month in review

The Central Bureau of Statistics hereby presents the most important preliminary findings regarding Foreign Trade for the month March of 2022. This review will focus only on the monetary value* of the imported and exported goods.



TOTAL IMPORTS TO THE FREE CIRCULATION AREA OF ARUBA BY SECTION, 2018 - 2022






