Consumer Price Index, base period December 2006

August 2016

The Central Bureau of Statistics presents the most important findings for the Consumer Price Index (CPI) for the month of August 2016.

The CPI for August 2016 is 117.17, a decrease of 0.6% compared to the index of July 2016 (117.82) and accumulating a decrease of 1.0% for the year 2016 up to and including August.

The percentage change of the CPI over the last twelve (12) months (August 2015 to August 2016) is -1.4%, a decrease of 2.1 percentage points (ppt) compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (0.7%).

The period average percentage change of the CPI for the period August 2015 - August 2016 is -0.9%, a decrease of 1.9 ppts compared to the period average percentage change over the period August 2014 - August 2015 (1.0%).

During this month, seven (7) of the twelve (12) sectors registered decreases in prices. The decreases which had the greatest influence on the CPI were registered for the "Transport" (-1.6%), "Recreation and culture" (-2.2%) and "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" (-0.5%) sectors, causing an effect of -0.27, -0.18 and -0.06 ppts, respectively. The decreases in the remaining sectors had an effect of -0.07 ppts on the CPI of August 2016.

Aforementioned decreases were partially offset mainly by an increase in the index for the "Housing" sector (0.1%), which had an influence of 0.02 ppts on the CPI of August 2016. The increases in the remaining sectors had an effect of 0.02 ppts on the CPI of August 2016.

The decrease in the "Transport" sector was caused by decreases of 2.4% and 4.0% in the categories "Operation of personal transport equipment" and "Transport services", which contributed to an effect of -0.21 and -0.06 ppts, respectively. The decrease in the "Recreation and culture" sector was mainly due to decreases in the categories "Holidays" (-14.9%) and "Audio-visual, photographic and information processing equipment" (-8.1%), which contributed to an effect of -0.12 and -0.07 ppts, respectively. The decrease in the "Food and non-alcoholic beverages" sector was due to a decrease in the category "Food" (-0.6%), which contributed to an effect of -0.07 ppts.

The increase in the "Housing" sector was caused by an increase of 0.1% in the category "Actual rentals for housing", which contributed to an effect of 0.02 ppts.

The consumption basket of the CPI consists of 452 goods and services. Compared to July 2016, 29.9% of these products had an increase in price, causing an effect of 0.20 ppts, while 30.8% showed a decrease, contributing to an effect of -0.75 ppts and the remaining 39.4% had no change in price. The prices of goods decreased by 0.6% and caused an influence of -0.38 ppts. The prices of services show a decrease of 0.5% and had an influence of -0.17 ppts on the CPI of August 2016.

The CPIC (core inflation) - CPI excluding the effect of energy and food – was 0.8% in August 2016, which is 0.3 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (1.1%). The energy index - which consists of the products: electricity, water, gasoline and diesel – is -7.2%, which is 6.6 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (-0.6%). The food index shows a decrease of 0.6%, which is 4.3 ppts lower compared to the percentage change for the same period of last year (3.7%).

The subsistence level for a household consisting of two (2) adults and two (2) children (aged 0-14 years) in August 2016 is Afl. 4,326, while for a single adult household it is Afl. 2,060.

Change in prices of crude oil, utilities, gasoline and diesel in August 2016

The prices of utilities (electricity and water), gasoline and diesel are for the greater part determined by international crude oil prices. In August 2016 the average price per barrel of crude oil (US\$ 44.54) had a decrease of US\$ 0.70 (-1.5%) compared to July 2016 (US\$ 45.24).

Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity up to 500 kWh did not change in August 2016, it stayed at Afl. 21.90 cents per kWh. Fuel surcharge for a usage of electricity between 501 -1000 kWh did not change in August 2016, it stayed at Afl. 27.80 cents per kWh. The prices of electricity and water did not change compared to July 2016. Subsequently, the average electricity price per household remained at Afl. 308.76, while the average price of water per household remained at Afl. 137.05.

In August 2016 the price of gasoline decreased by Afl. 6.90 cents (-3.9%) causing an effect of -0.20 ppts on the CPI. The price of diesel registered a decrease of Afl. 5.90 cents (-4.2%) and had an effect of -0.01 ppt on the CPI of August 2016.

In August 2016, utilities, gasoline and diesel as a group show a decrease in price of 1.1% compared to July 2016, and had an influence of -0.21 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining 448 goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease of 0.4% in price, causing an effect of -0.35 ppts on the CPI.

Change in prices of Food & catering services in August 2016

The "Food & catering services" index shows a decrease of 0.3% in August 2016, after a decrease of 0.4% in July 2016. The index for "Food at home" shows a decrease of 0.5% in August, as eight (8) of the eleven (11) "Food at home" indices decreased in August 2016. The "Fruit" index registered the largest decrease (-1.7%) in August 2016. Furthermore, decreases were posted in the indices for "Milk, cheese and eggs" (-1.6%), "Vegetables" (-1.6%) and "Food products n.e.c." (-0.3%). The "Potatoes and other tubers" index registered the largest increase (2.5%). Furthermore, increases of 0.8% and 0.3% were posted in the indices for "Oils and fats" and "Non-alcoholic beverages", respectively.

Over the last twelve (12) months the "Food & catering services" index has decreased by 0.6%. The "Food at home" index shows a decrease of 1.1%. The "Milk, cheese and eggs" index decreased by 8.3%, the largest decrease among the "Food at home" food groups, while the "Potatoes and other tubers" index shows the largest increase (4.4%).

The index for "Food away from home" was unchanged in August 2016 for the second straight month and has increased by 1.2% over the last twelve (12) months.

In August 2016, "Food at home" and "Food away from home" as a group show a decrease in price of 0.3% compared to July 2016, and had an influence of -0.06 ppts on the CPI, while the remaining goods and services, as a group, experienced a decrease in price of 0.6%, causing an effect of -0.49 ppts on the CPI.
