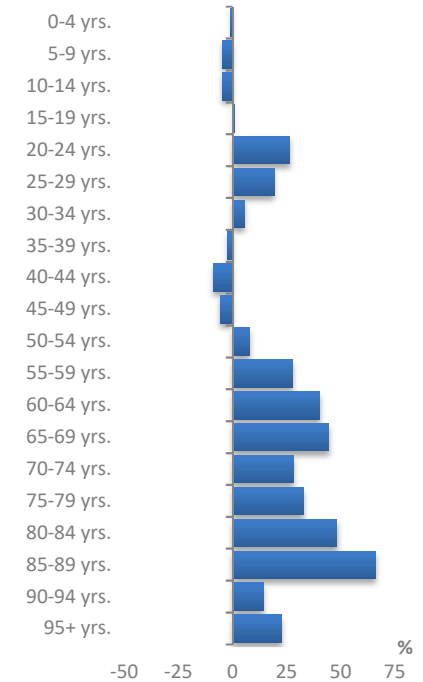

Graph 1. Population change 2010-2017

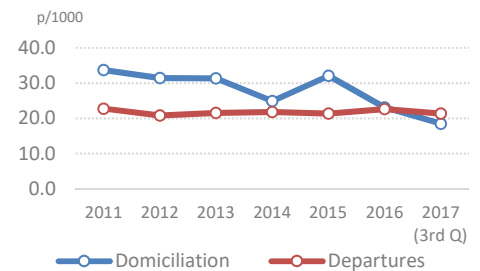


Migration remains the main driver of population growth in Aruba, with 21,516 persons registering at the Population Registry Office since the 2010 Census up to the 3rd quarter 2017. The greater majority of those registering are foreign-born, (on average about 71 per 100 persons). The total number of persons registering shows a decreasing trend since 2011 (see graph 2), except in 2015 where immigration shows an increase of 9.8 percent compared to the average growth during 2011-2014.

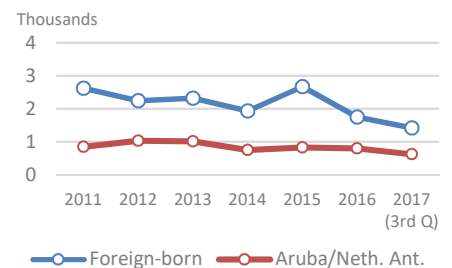
Overall, the largest source country of persons registering has been the Netherlands. Since 2012, the Netherlands has accounted for more than 25 percent of foreign-born registrations. In 2015, even though in total they still accounted for about 27 percent of all foreign-born registrations, the growth in number of registrations was mainly due to an increase in the number of persons from Venezuela and the Dominican Republic. The latter represented an increase of 60 respectively 50 percent compared to the calculated average during 2011-2014.

A total of 16,755 departures were registered during the same period of 2010-2017. The departures remained stable over the aforementioned years at about 2,330 per year. Half of all persons de-registering were born in Aruba/Netherlands Antilles.

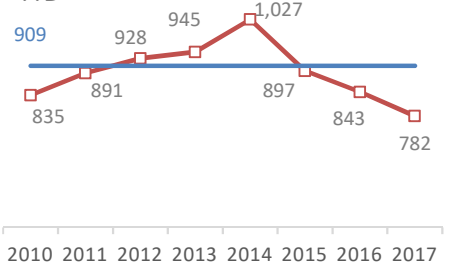

Graph 4. Births and 2010-2016 avg, YTD¹



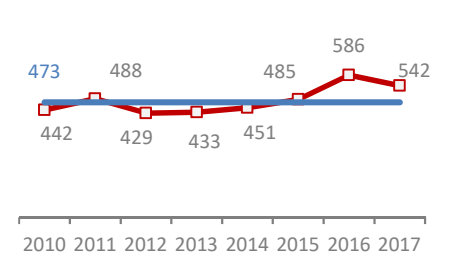

Graph 6. Domiciliation and 2010-2016 avg, YTD¹

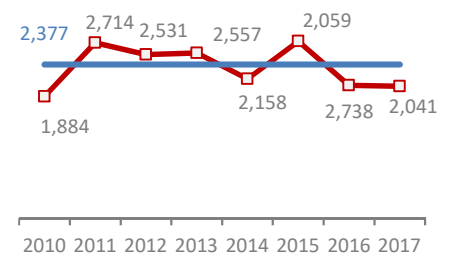

Graph 7. Departures and 2010-2016 avg, YTD¹

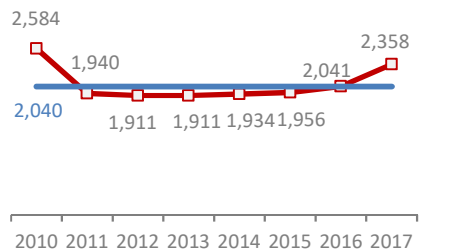
